New Databases, Expanded Coverage and Linking Options

The new year brings new databases and expanded coverage to *HSL Online*. We have increased the number of full text journals to 85, added the BioethicsLine database, and added the ability to search all MEDLINE or all HealthSTAR files at one time.

The addition of another 70 journals to the full text collections allows searchers to view, print and save articles from 85 journals with coverage from 1995 to present in most cases and from 1993 to present for the 15 core journals. Full text files, including the Nursing and Mental Health collections, can be searched individually or can be linked from a MEDLINE, CINAHL or PsycINFO search.

The BioethicsLine database includes materials on bioethics selected from the literature of medicine, nursing, biology, philosophy, religion, law and the behavioral sciences. Selections from popular literature are also included. Developed jointly by the Kennedy Institute of Ethics and the National Library of Medicine, documents include journal and newspaper articles, monographs, court decisions, bills, laws and audiovisual materials.

Searchers now have the option of searching all MEDLINE or all HealthSTAR files at one time. MEDLINE can now be searched from 1966 to the present, and HealthSTAR from 1975 to the present. The option of searching by segmented years is still available, with the most recent years' file (i.e. MEDLINE 1993-present) remaining as the default selection.

Alumna Donation Expands Full Text Collection

Dr. Gloria S. Hope (MA NUR) class of 1963 sponsored the acquisition of Ovid Full Text: The Nursing Collection. This collection was recently added to HSL Online (see cover story).

The Nursing Collection contains the full text of 14 leading journals in both general and specialized nursing fields, with hypertext links to the MEDLINE and CINAHL (Cumulative Index of Nursing and Allied Health) bibliographic databases and the other Ovid Full Text Collections. Online Printing Charges

The Health Sciences Library System has experienced a rapid increase in the cost of providing free online laser printing. These uncontrolled and increasing costs have made it necessary for HSLS to recover printing costs. Effective January 12, 1998, the HSLS instituted a networked printing system which operates on the same vendacard system as the photocopy machines and maintains the same per page costs.

Laser printing charges are implemented in the following HSLS Libraries: Falk Library of the Health Sciences; Western Psychiatric Institute and Clinic Library; School of Nursing Library and Learning Resource Center; and Bergman Library at Montefiore University Hospital.

Patrons still have the option of downloading their print job to a diskette and printing it at a location of their choice. There is no charge for printing from dedicated PITTCAT terminals.

NAR Online, the online version of Nucleic Acids Research, is now available on the World Wide Web. Table of Contents, abstracts and full text are available for all issues from 1995 to the present. Articles can be viewed and downloaded in one of three formats: HTML, PDF, or PostScript. Images, graphs and charts are included in the full text, and references are linked to their MEDLINE records. A Table of Contents email service is also available.

Printing Alternatives

Option 1

Carry a diskette with you when you come to an HSLS Library. Any file you create on any library computer can be copied to a diskette and printed from your home/office computer or at any CIS Lab. (Students receive 1,400 free print pages per semester from CIS.) Diskettes may be purchased from Falk Library's Microcomputer & Media Center (MMC).

Option 2

Use ftp (file transfer protocol) to send the file to your UNIX/VMS account. FTP will work on any computer in Falk Library's MMC and WPIC's PC Lab. (FTP will not work from HSL Online terminals in the libraries.) Print the file at another location or use a PostScript printer from the VMS and UNIX Timesharing Services.

Option 3

Use the email option on HSL Online. When doing a search in HSL Online OVID Databases, such as MEDLINE, you can email the citations to your email account. This feature is available from the save option.
